OUTPATIENT COUNSELING & SOBER LIVING



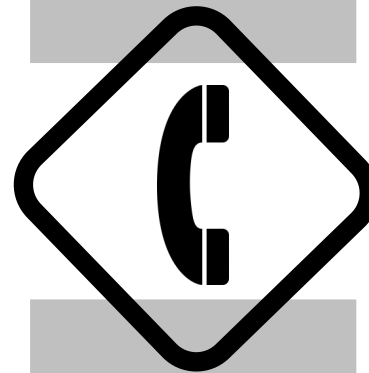
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MEDICALLY ASSISTED TREATMENT (MAT)



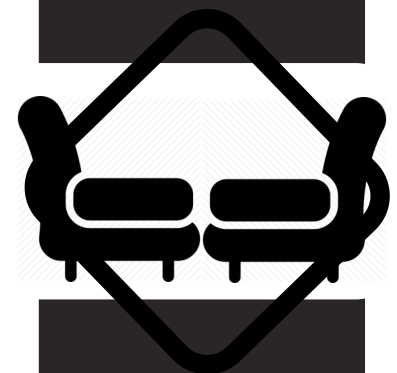
Use of medication with counseling and behavioral therapy to treat substance use disorder and prevent opioid overdose.
